

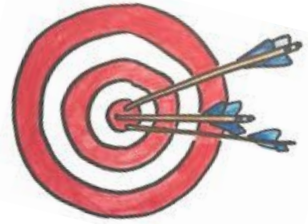


TDP LEVEL 2 Reading Learning Targets

Unit 1: Conflict Leads to Change

Students will be able analyze realistic fiction and nonfiction by:

- Describing a story's character, setting, or events by using specific details
- Comparing and contrasting characters, settings, or events using details from the story
- Describing how the plot evolves, including how characters change, throughout a text
- Describing how points of view influence the description of events
- Analyzing how an author develops a narrator or speaker's point of view
